



Vaccinate against the new influenza

We are currently vaccinating persons considered to be in the high-risk group and young children. However, all other residents in Blekinge will be offered the vaccination as from week 48 (23 - 27 November). Please contact your local medical welfare centre for further information about where and when you can get vaccinated.
